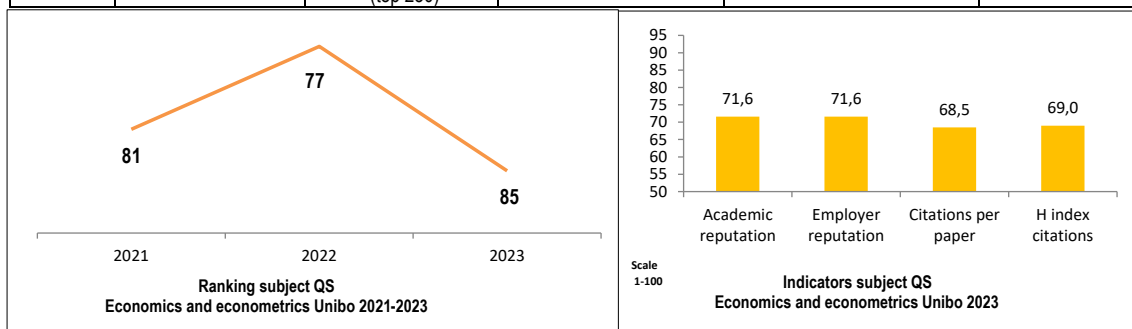

In the subject QS **Economics and econometrics**, **Unibo** ranks second, best in Italy, 85th in the world top 520. Bologna is the best public university in Italy, overtaken only by the private Bocconi university, which has levels of funding not comparable to public universities.

PROCEDURE ADOPTED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE FOR QUALITY ASSURANCE TO ESTIMATE THE CONTRIBUTION OF EACH DEPARTMENT

-Analysis of the population of each department (31 December 2022) and of the SSDs of each researcher (professors and researchers on permanent and fixed-term contracts);

-identification by the Executive Committee for quality assurance of the SSDs that characterise each subject (on a scale from 0 to 10);

-identification of each department's level of contribution to each subject according to this scheme ::

**PREVALENT** accounts for at least 50% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject;

**SIGNIFICANT BUT NOT PREVALENT** accounts for at least 50% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject;

**MINOR BUT PERTINENT** accounts for less than 20% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject.

No mention is given to subjects unrelated to at least 4 research staff. And, the subjects in which the university has not been.
